HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Before the war and the genocide of 1994, Rwanda had inadequate Health workers both in number and quality, this was worsened by war and Genocide of 1994. To address this situation, the Government of National Unity established KHI in June 1996; and through an act of parliament law number 07/ 2002 of 22/2/02.

The first three departments to be opened were :

- Anesthesia;
- Physiotherapy
- Nursing/midwifery.

Progressively KHI introduced:

- Mental health nursing
- Dentistry
- Medical Laboratory Technology
- Radiography
- Environment Health Sciences
- Ophthalmic clinical officers program.

Enrollment has increased from 96 students in 1996 to 1020 in 2005 with a Male to Female ratio of 3: 2.

- A center for Continuing medical education (CEFOCK) was established in 2001.

C. GRADUATES

Our graduates are awarded with Higher National Diplomas (A1). Beginning with 2006, degree programmes will commence in :

FEES STRUCTURE

For government sponsored students fees include the following,

- 21.000 frw tuition fees payed every year through the goverment scholarship.
- 3000 frw registration fees at admission.
- 35.000 frw caution money payable once at admission and refunded at completion of studies if no property of The institute has been damaged by the student.

- Dissertation fees 100.000 frw equivalent to 180 US \$/in the final year
- Clinical placements fees is 100.000 frw equivalent to 180 US \$ per year.

- Meals: 210.000 Frw equivalent to 375 US \$. (in campus)

- Dissertation fees 100.000 frw equivalent to 180 US \$/in the final year
- Clinical placements fees is 100.000 frw equivalent to 180 US \$ per year.
